## **Additional information for trade stand owners stopping with us.**

### **BVG/YFC Scrapheap Challenge 2010 (World Cup Penalty King)**

**Free entry, open to all comers – Prizes for class winners**

Entrants should create prior to coming to the event, a mechanical device for kicking a standard sized football into a goal from a penalty spot 12 yards from goal (for two of them a blindfolded goalkeeper will be in place). Each device will fire five penalties in turn. The winner will be the one who scores most out of 5 attempts. Sudden death to be used in the event of a tie. to be judged on distance reached. The 'foot' which kicks the ball must start at least 30cm from the ball prior to the ball being struck. The firing device must remain in one piece during the duration of the 'kick' i.e. firing a missile at the ball to propel it is forbidden. To enter, the competitors must be able to lift, pull or drag the device into the competition ring under their own strength.

The judge will take the health and safety of participant's entries into account and will be able to prevent participants from competing if the device is deemed too dangerous. Judge's decision is final. Please indicate intension to enter on the form overleaf.
