THE GATHERING IS RUN UNDER THE INSURANCE POLICY OF SUE RYDER CARE INSURERS, HSBC AND WE MUST ENSURE THAT FULL PRECAUTIONS ARE TAKEN IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE EVENT RISK ASSESSMENT: THE SAFETY OFFICER HAS THE FINAL WORD ON THE RALLY FIELD.

1. *A speed limit of 5 MPH will apply on the rally field to all vehicles.*
2. *Exhibits must be in a safe condition whether running or not.*
3. *All exhibits must be insured for public liability for at least £2,000,000*
4. *Tractors will only carry one person regardless of the number of seats fitted.*
5. *No one will be carried other than in the passenger seat of a commercial vehicle.*
6. *Boiler Inspection & Insurance Certificates must be brought to the event. Failure to produce this on request will result in exclusion from the rally field.*
7. *All exhibitors are requested to be on the rally field by 9.30 am. On both days and are asked not to leave before 4 pm on both days. On arrival please report to your steward.*
8. *Dogs to be kept on lead at all times. Please clean up after them, placing in bins provided.*
9. *A commemorative memento will be given to all exhibitors (one per exhibitor) upon production of your exhibit number, your voucher and £2.50 after 4 pm SUNDAY.*
